



TAMA Ron Gall Scholarship for Industry Leadership

Background

The TAMA Ron Gall Scholarship for Industry Leadership was established in October 2021. The scholarship is a one-off \$2000 grant sponsored by Tulloch Farm Machines to recognise the contribution of the late Ron Gall to the tractor and machinery sector. Ron was TAMA general manager from 2014 to early 2021 and his hard work, dedication and commitment transformed our organisation into a real industry voice and presence.

Details

The TAMA Ron Gall Scholarship for Industry Leadership will be awarded to a current industry leader for professional development. The successful applicant will attend the TAMA Conference in August 2022 and make a presentation on how the scholarship has contributed to their career development.

Criteria:

This scholarship is open to employees in the tractor and machinery industry who work for a current TAMA ordinary or dealer member. Applicants are required to submit the following information to generalmanager@tama.org.nz:

1. A letter outlining:

- The details of the qualification or training course they wish to complete and why they wish to complete it (through any provider)
- Their career and leadership aspirations
- The qualification(s) they have already gained and how the qualification(s) has benefited their career
- Any evidence of current business or personal leadership that may add value to their application.

2. A letter of support from their senior manager.

Scholarship value:

\$2,000 towards further study or professional development plus a framed certificate.

Timing:

Applications close **Friday 21 January 2022**. The successful recipient will be selected by the TAMA management group and announced online in February 2022.
