## **TAMA 2022 Scholarship Terms and Conditions**

Please read these terms and conditions carefully to ensure your application is considered. Incomplete applications or applications received after **5pm, Friday 29 April 2022** will not be considered.

- You must be working full time in the tractor and machinery sector for an employer who is a current TAMA ordinary or dealer member.
- The scholarships must be used within one year of being awarded.
- The scholarship is not transferable to another person.
- The scholarship is not transferable to another place of employment should you change employer before the scholarship is completed, unless the new employer is within the same industry, is a current TAMA member and they are willing to support you; and your previous employer and TAMA both agree to the transfer.
- The scholarship must be used to contribution towards expenditure which promotes the recipient's professional development.
- TAMA will publish details of the scholarship recipients and may ask for further information to help promote TAMA and the scholarship programme
- Recipients may be required to give an oral presentation at a TAMA organised event
- A selection panel will be convened by TAMA. The panel reserves the right to request further supporting information. The panel's decision is final.
